The year was 1932. Amelia Earhart was flying alone from North America to England in a small single—engined aero plane. At midnight, several hours after she had left Newfoundland, she ran into bad weather. To make things worse, her altimeter (高度表) failed and she didn't know how high she was flying. Sleep is not the same every night. We experience some deep sleep and some active sleep(积极

In the spring of 1926, Yan Qingbao, a 43-year-old farmer, discovered a circular piece of jade(\pm) while digging a hole. Driven by curiosity, he dug deeper and found a group of about 400 colourful jade pieces.

At the time, he had no idea that his discovery would be as important as other wonders of the world such as China's Great Wall and Egypt's pyramids. Since then more than 10000 relics, dating back to between 5000 and 3000 BC have been unearthed at Shanxingdui. These relics include gold, pottery, bone tools and ivory objects. They prove that Shanxingdui contains the ruins of an ancient city that wasonce the political, economic and cultural center of the ancient Shu Kingdom-the old name for Sichuan.

It has helped modern historians realize that Sichuan's human history goes back more than 5000 years. And, located on the upper part of the Yangtze River, the site challenges the common idea that Chinese civilization rose from a single source-the Yellow River valley.

Shanxingdui was named the Scientific Education Base for China's Youth in March this year.But still, only four of the Shanxingdui Ruins 12 square kilometers have been uncovered. Who knows what other big surprises are waiting to be shown to the world.

In the middle of the 1800s, France was considered the most important place in the world for art. One reason for that was the Academy, a government organization with some strict r_l__ about art. It decided what could and could not be art. In order to be accepted by the Academy, an artist had to be very talented. Artists also had to paint exactly the way the Academy wanted them to. A brave group of painters challenged(挑战)these ideas and changed art f__2_

Each year, the Academy had an exhibition of the art they had decided was the best. In 1864, a group of artists became a ___3___ because they didn't get into the show. They felt that their paintings were not bad; the paintings were just different. After complaining to the government, these artists were given their own show.

The Academy thought all art should look realistic(逼真).But these artists were more interested in trying to show movement and the bright colors of daylight. In their opinion, it was more real to show these than it was to paint a scene(场景)which was as s__4__as a photo. It was also more interesting to show all of the different. colours when light hits an object like water. By 1874, many different artists were. painting in this new style, including Claude Monet. One of his paintings had the title, *Impression: sunrise*. A critic(评论家)h__5__these new artists. He used Monet's title to make fun of these painters by calling them"*Impressionists* (印象派)", meaning that they didn't make real paintings. The critics who liked these artists thought the word was just right. They began to use it happily. They thought it was more important to paint h_6__they saw things instead of just what they saw. Other artists around the world felt that they could have this freedom as well. Because of the impressionists, the art w 7 was never the same.

Liu Yaxuan is totally a homebody. Every weekend, this 14-year-old student from Tsinghua High School watches popular TV dramas like *The Journey of Flower* (《花千骨》) and plays with her mobile phone. She hates playing outdoor sports. "It's too tiring," she said.



She is not alone. In recent years, more and more Chinese teenagers are becoming homebodies. A 2013 survey of kids aged 2 to 14 showed about half of them spend less than one hour doing outdoor activities every day.

To some extent, heavy *academic pressure* (学业压力) caused this *phenomenon* (现象). Hu Huilan, 12, from Shenzhen Nanshan Language School, is busy with piles of homework and extra classes on weekends. "I don't want to get behind," she said.

Even if this isn't a problem, kids still prefer indoor life. Wang Yidi, 12, from Anhui No. 50 Middle School, often reads Harry Potter, listens to music and surfs the Internet at home. "I can do so many things I like at home rather than hang out in *smoggy* (雾霾的) weather," she said.

But this causes bad health conditions. Chinese teenagers' physical conditions have been *declining* (下降) for more than 25 years, reported People's Daily last year.

The situation for foreign students is quite different. Zhang Yingke, 15, from Unionville High School in Toronto, Canada, says her peers are not homebodies at all. "They spend their free time outdoors even if it just means going to the park or reading a book under the tree. Nice weather, little homework and rich outdoor activities enable us to do that," she said. After being there for four years, she has fallen in love with running and playing tennis. "It helps me stay energetic," she said.

"Who am I?" Do you often ask this question? Knowing yourself may be one of the most difficult things in the world. But it's certainly \underline{w} 81 trying. You're sure to discover more about yourself after some unforgettable activities.

On March 20, 55 students told their stories on the topic of "The Time I Discovered or Freed Myself" at the 13th China Daily "21st Century Cup" National High School English Speaking Competition in Kaifeng, Henan.



The champion, Xia Xiaowen, 15, from Shanghai Foreign Language School talked about how she found her true interest in debating. Xia was a p 82 student in her studies and often won first prize, but she had few hobbies in her spare time. However, she found her real *passion* (热爱的事物) after joining a debate tournament. "Debating changes me," Xia said. "I find real happiness in meeting wonderful arguments and knowing many students who s 83 the same interest with me."

Third place Lu Yunsong found his brave side during a *military training* (军训). The 12-year-old from Beijing RDFZ Chaoyang School kept complaining <u>u</u> 84 he saw a friend bravely overcome difficulties. He chose to stick with it and finished the training proudly. "I've realized I'm not a little boy anymore," Lu said. "I'm a man, who is strong and brave."

"Growing up is a <u>p__85</u> of knowing yourself," said Feng Feifei, global business development manager of BBC Learning English and one of the judges. "You may discover your *potentials* (潜力); you may also find the room for improvement."

Cities released by Xinhua News Agency and the China Association of Mayors. This is the second year in a row that the capital city of Sichuan is chosen.

So what has made Chengdu such a happy place to live? As People's Daily said, "Part of the reason is the leisurely and slow-paced (慢节奏的) lifestyle that many people in Chengdu live."

To find the pleasures of the Chengdu lifestyle, the first thing you should try is the food. Chengdu cooking style is famous for the use of the Sichuanese *peppercorn* (花椒) and hot *chillies* (辣椒). "Nothing is more important to Chengdu people than food," said Du Li, a professor at the Sichuan Higher Institute of Cuisine. "They love to find small restaurants in out-of-the-way places that have great tastes." There are around 40,000 restaurants in Chengdu, the highest *density* (密度) of restaurants of any city in the world.

Another important part of Chengdu life is the teahouses. Found everywhere in the city, the teahouses are much more than just a place to drink tea. Teahouses are places to do business, meet with friends, show off pet birds, listen to Chuanju (Sichuan opera), and most importantly, play *mahjong* (麻将). As a local saying goes, "If you cannot find someone, he or she is playing mahjong, or on their way to play mahjong."

The operation, which lasted for over four hours, proved to be very difficult because of the hard resin which covered the skin. The doctors removed a section of the mummy and sent it to a laboratory. They also found something which the X-ray of the god Duamutef. This god which has the head of a cow was normally placed inside a mummy. The doctors have not yet decided how the woman died. They feared that the mummy would fall to pieces when they cut it open, but fortunately this has not happened. The mummy successfully survived the operation.

"I decided to write a letter about all the things he told us when we were young," Allende explains. Later, he wrote a long letter which became Allende's first novel, *The House of the Spirits*.

"I spent ten, twelve hours a day in a room, writing," Allende says, "I don't talk to anybody; I don't answer the phone." When she finishes the first *draft* (草稿) of a new novel, Allende mails a copy to her *toughest critic* (最严厉的评论家). "I send it to my mother in Chile. She reads it and comes here with a red pencil. We fight for a month at least." Allende then goes back to work until she feels the book is finished. "The storytelling is the fun part," she says. "The writing can be a lot of work!"

Lesson80 The Crystal Palace 水晶宫

Perhaps the most extraordinary building of the nineteenth century was the Crystal Palace, which was built in Hyde Park for the Great Exhibition of 1851. The Crystal Palace was different from all other buildings in the world, for it was made of iron and glass. It was one of the biggest buildings of all time and a lot of people from many countries came to see it. A great many goods were sent to the exhibition from various parts of the world. There was also a great deal of machinery on display. The most wonderful piece of machinery on show was Nasmyth's steam hammer. Though in those days, travelling was not as easy as it is today, steam boats carried thousands of visitors across the Channel from Europe. On arriving in England, they were taken to the Crystal Palace by train. There were six million visitors in all, and the profits from the exhibition were used to build museums and colleges. Later, the Crystal Palace was moved to South London. It remained one of the most famous buildings in the world until it was burnt down in 1936.

这种方法一般单纯地表示将来某个时间将要发生的动作或存在的状态。will 用于各种人称;shall 只用于第一人称。 例如:I will / shall go to visit him next week. 下周我将去拜访他。

What time shall we go there tomorrow? 明天我们几点去那儿?

2、be going to 动词原形

be going to 相当于一个助动词(其中 be 有人称和数的变化),与它后面的动词原形一起构成谓语。用来表示近期将要发生的动作或存在的状态,以及计划、安排、打算要做的事。例如: There is going to be a football match this afternoon.今天下午将有一场足球赛。

2)、常用结构

- 三、一般将来时 用法

The Green Belt Movement is a community-based group in Kenya. It aims to help protect the environment,

mainly through planting trees.

The Green Belt Movement was started in 1977 by Wangari Maathai. When Wangari started the Green Belt Movement, she thought much about both people and the environment. She thought that if people grew the trees themselves, it would help them to understand the environment and develop their local cultures.

Today, the Green Belt Movement works like this. Members from the Movement go to communities to talk about tree planting and starting *nurseries*(苗圃). If the local people are interested, they can join the Movement as a group. When they join, they receive a lot of information about how to prepare the *soil*(土壤), and collect and grow seeds. When the people know what to do, they can collect seeds, plant them into *seedlings*(幼苗). When the seedlings are big enough, they will be planted on farms. The Green Belt Movement pays the nursery money for each seedling that is still alive after three months.

The Green Belt Movement now has over 6000 community nurseries in Kenya, and many more in other African countries. Over the last 30 years, it has planted more than 30 million trees in parks and on farms.

The Green Belt Movement also runs programs to help people start gardens and grow plants that are local to their area. This means that many communities can now take care of almost all their own food needs, and they can often make extra income as well.

In 2004, Wangari Maathai won the Nobel Peace Prize. Giving the prize to Wangari showed that peace doesn't just mean stopping wars. It can also mean making the world a better place to live in.
